



# Decimal Double Compare

## You need

- Decimal Cards, Set A (2 sets)

## Play with a partner.

- 1 Mix the cards and deal them evenly so that each player has the same number of cards. Place the cards facedown in front of you.
- 2 Each player turns over the top two cards in his or her stack.
- 3 Look at your two numbers and your partner's two numbers. Decide which player has the larger sum.
- 4 Whoever has the larger sum takes all of the cards that have been turned over and places them at the bottom of his or her stack.
- 5 If both sums are the same, each player keeps his or her cards. Turn over the next two cards.
- 6 Play for a given amount of time or until one player has all of the cards. The player with more cards wins.

## Variations

Follow the rules above, making one or more of these adjustments:

- The person with the smaller sum takes the cards.
- Include Set B of the Decimal Cards.
- Add new cards. Use either "wild cards" (which could be any number) or "equivalent cards," such as 0.50 or 0.950.
